When mounted 3 inches from the floor or ground, the switch complies with U.S. ADA and Canadian guidelines, and gives door access to anyone whether they are disabled or simply have their hands full. A tapered surface makes the switch safer if run into, and serves to deflect hard-hitting carts and conveyances. A number of wiring options simplify new and retrofit options.
